Guidelines for Students



1. UNIFORM

Schools provide a safe space where students are treated equally and fairly. A basic aim of any school is to prevent difference or discrimination within students. The world discriminates on a variety of aspects including wealth, tastes, and preferences and so on. A uniform dress code prevents talk or thoughts that focus on anything other than the education of the mind, body and soul for which the school exists.

Anand Niketan firmly believes in promoting a child's individuality in thoughts and actions. As a school we do not find that expressing individuality in terms of fashion or clothing is necessary or even beneficial to a child's mind. Hence as a school we believe that students must have a uniform dress code and ensure that the focus is kept on thoughts and actions.

- · Student should wear the prescribed school uniform and modification is not permitted.
- · Uniform should be properly washed and ironed.
- · Students not in school uniform will not be permitted to attend class.
- · Shirts should be buttoned up and tucked in.
- · Low waist trousers are not allowed.
- · Only black bands and black clips are permitted.
- · Long hair should be properly tied or plaited.
- · Boys must keep their hair short and neatly combed.
- · Fancy haircut and highlighting of hair is not permitted.
- · Nails should be trimmed regularly.
- · Fancy jewellery is not allowed. Girls are only allowed to wear small studs in the ears.
- · Wearing I-Card is essential at all times during school hours and in the school bus.
- We understand that sometimes due to unavoidable circumstances students may not be able to come to school in the prescribed school
 uniform. A note from parents maybe accepted but not more than once in a term.
